
This concerns our telephone conversation of today about the recent siltation of the McKownville Reservoir. The McKownville Improvement Association will appreciate receiving data from your Department that establishes the holding capacity of the reservoir. I have noted that within the past year or more that a long sand bar has formed in the west end of the reservoir. This was not present two years ago.

Our Association has been in contact with the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation on the matter. We have expressed our concern to them about the heavy silting of the reservoir and they have asked our help in obtaining a siltation history of the body of water. I hope you can help us in providing such information.

The reservoir is an asset to McKownville and we do want to maintain it as a pond or small recreational lake. Too, it is still listed as a water supply by the NYS Department of Health. The primary use now is scenic and as a skating pond in the winter but it may be possible to develop it for other uses as well.
