AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 204 FOR 2000 TO INCLUDE THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS BETWEEN SUNY AT ALBANY AND STUYVESANT PLAZA AS PART OF THE FULLER ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT IN THE TOWN OF GUILDERLAND

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 204 for 2000, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with Hudson River Construction, Co., Inc. regarding road paving and striping which includes the portion of Fuller Road in the Town of Guilderland, and

WHEREAS, In April of this year the Department of Public Works hosted an open house for the Fuller Road Paving and Striping Project in which many citizens expressed concern regarding sidewalks on the section of Fuller Road from SUNY at Albany to Stuyvesant Plaza, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works has recommended that approximately 2000 feet of asphalt sidewalk be constructed within the existing County right-of-way on the west side of Fuller Road from Executive Park to Loughlin Street, and

WHEREAS, In order to construct said sidewalks, the County must amend the existing paving and striping contract with Hudson River Construction Co., Inc., at an estimated cost of \$30,000, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works indicated that there are State Consolidated Highway Improvement Program (CHIPS) funds available to offset the additional cost of constructing the sidewalk, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 204 for 2000 is amended to reflect that the scope of services to be provided by Hudson River Construction Co., Inc. shall include the excavation, curb reconstruction and gravel needed to prepare the site at Fuller Road for the installation of sidewalks as indicated above, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
