About an hour ago we learned that Bast Hatfield, our contractor for the McKownville Water and Storm Sewer Projects, would like to get into the McKownville neighborhoods and perform restoration and clean-up tasks. Normally we would have presented the contractor's schedule and request to start work to the property owners in McKownville at least a couple of weeks prior to the work starting. But, given the growing concerns around Covid19, and the Governor's decisions to shut down many construction projects, we are taking advantage at this time to get as much restoration and clean-up completed as possible. Just in case the "essential projects" are shut down as well.

Bast Hatfield will have people on site beginning this Monday, March 30, 2020. The contractor will be performing cleanup and restoration work throughout all of the streets that have been affected by the construction projects.

The Town of Guilderland Water and Street Departments will be coordinating as well so we can get things tidied up quickly just in case we are shut down.

We would favor the McKownville residents to understand why there wasn't sufficient notice prior to the work starting so if you can please forward this information to the folks in McKownville it will be very helpful and much appreciated.
